

IBA JUDGE

Judge Selection Criteria

The Indies Technical Committee will select judges from an Expression of Interest application that potential IBA Judges need to submit by **3rd May 2019**.

IBA Judges may include – but are not limited to – recognised brewers, industry consultants, associate members, industry suppliers and beer writers.

Prospective judges must have sensory judging experience, must participate in regular flavour panels or competitions and must communicate in fluent written and verbal English.

IBA Judges will be selected under the following Selection Criteria;

1. Previous judging experience or beer evaluation experience;
2. industry and peer recognition;
3. industry qualifications – BJCP, Cicerone, IBD Master Brewer, Institute of Brewing (Faults & Flaws), Diploma in Brewing, other formal qualifications;
4. extensive knowledge of beer styles and the brewing process;
5. sensory training and exceptional flavour and fault perception; and
6. positive judging demeanor.

All applicants are required to provide a CV/résumé and two references.

Selection Process

Applications will be short listed by IBA staff and assessed by the Indies Technical Committee in accordance with the Indies Selection Criteria.

Applicants who are deemed ineligible or under qualified may be offered an opportunity as an Associate Judge. Feedback will be sent to all unsuccessful applicants with recommendations for education or training that will improve future applications.

Successful applicants will be communicated with directly to offer position and provide more details.

Judges are assigned by the Technical Committee and Competition Manager to appropriate judging tables specific to mix of qualifications and experience.
